- **Children's Education:** supported children with writing books, pens, and uniforms
- **Other:** teachings on how youth can identify and recognize opportunities and use them for the creation of income and self-employment
 - The team provided training for youth to help them create employment opportunities, earn money, support their families, and participate in national activities.

NATIONAL/CENTER CHALLENGES DURING 2023

- A big challenge that has been facing the ministry is to get an authorization of working all over the country. Currently we do not go beyond the region. There are fellows who are excitedly want to establish centers at their places, but we can't join them till we are allowed to work in all the regions by the government.

UPCOMING PLANS FOR 2024/2025

- To capacitate 5 staff on level 3 Counseling courses and other spiritual trainings so that they can be more conversant or counseling people in different needs.
- Be able to reach at least 200 disabled people who can do small jobs, to empower them and provide them with some support so that they can afford making some ornamental things and sew things like carpets and other decorations so they can sell and generate income to support their families.
- Continue writing different developmental proposals that aimed at helping widows and orphans
- Start teaching counseling level one and have at least 4 youth seminar conference in year 2024

- The ministry has not received any grants, projects funds from other groups except what the Samaritans contribute to the ministry for running some activities at the ministry.
