TESTIMONY OF TSERENDULAM BUD



When I first joined GSM, I was deeply hurt by the church, not able to forgive myself, and physically very sick My relationship with God was shaky; I no longer felt the Holy Spirit, and my heart was filled with hatred, unforgiveness, complaints, anger, and stress. Also, I had a lot of family relationship problems. My eldest son tried to commit suicide and cut his forearms many times, and he had a lot of mental pressure and was constantly afraid. All my siblings were sexually abused, so there were a lot of psychological and spiritual problems. I was raped several times by my brothers when I was young.

By the grace of the Lord and the guidance of the Holy Spirit, many of these things were healed, freed, put in order, and the heart was healed with forgiveness. I was afraid of a lot of people, especially our former pastor. I was blamed for all the problems by the leader of the church; they told me Tsegii cursed the church and Tsegii was from the devil. Now, I see and think about those elders and pastors; I feel sympathy for them, can discern their souls, and want to be truly empathetic. I have attended GSM services for more than one year now, including many online meetings. I also participated in counselor training 1 and 2. GSM provided me with oneon-one individual sessions that helped me realize the problems and much deep healing came. I also joined the Wednesday group for a few months. My husband attended a men's meeting for seven months. I forgive many people, including myself.

He counseled for several months and prayed many times for Otgonbaatar and his wife, Altantuya. After praying and counseling Altantuya, her life of faith was restored, and she began to walk with God again. Otgonbaatar fell into the hole, and his bones cracked and his brain was damaged. After her husband was injured, Altantuya was very afraid, but our prayer delivered her. Also, in our prayer meeting, Otgonbaatar's recovery is progressing quickly, and he is now walking. I prayed that my family would love to have a child. To God be the glory.

THIS IS AN ADDENDUM TO THE MONGOLIA 2023 ANNUAL REPORT:

Seven new GSM centers were established in Mongolia this past June after a whirlwind tour by national director Yanjmaa Jutmaan. Yanjmaa was called into ministry by Bettie Mitchell in the spring of 2006 when the two met – seemingly by chance – in South Korea.

The tour encompassed three countries, starting with a stopover in Toronto, where two people accepted the Lord. Then it was on to Korea, where Yanjmaa's sister Dashka organized four services for Mongolian-speaking residents in several churches. Sixteen people became Christians during Yanjmaa's three days there and many were healed and delivered. Some of the Mongolians there have been taking Level One counseling training from Yanjmaa, which is the GSM curriculum translated into Mongolian. One of the pastors invited Yanjmaa because he was impressed with the maturity of her counselor trainees.

Arriving in the capital Mongolian city of Ulaanbaatar, Yanjmaa was met by a team of people who had printed up T-shirts, reserved meeting spaces, and printed out enormous banners for what would be a series of packed meetings to disciple Mongolian believers. At this point, a fellow missionary from North Carolina, Samuel Stutts, showed up to minister alongside Yanjmaa. He was of major help along the way.

Yanjmaa first set up a new board of directors and installed an in-country manager, Dagvadorj, who proceeded to accompany Yanjmaa on her tour of the country. The little group drove to the central Mongolian cities of Erdenet and Darkhan. The drive included a roadside deliverance for one of her drivers, a lesbian, who is now Yanjmaa's new accountant.

In Darkhan, they stayed at the home of a woman whose brother is a shaman (somewhat like a witch doctor) and Yanjmaa did deliverance prayers there. At Burhant Jesus Church there, the service drew people from as far away as Irkutsk in southern Siberia. Yanjmaa prayed for many people to receive gifts of the Holy Spirit. Many diseases were healed; in fact, some people who had gotten healed via Yanjmaa's weekly online services showed up in person to testify.

At the Erdenet service, one woman's leg was healed. About 50 people – which is a lot for a Mongolian service outside the capital – attended.

Then Yanjmaa flew to Khovd, an isolated city in far western Mongolia where she'd worked for three years as Mongolia's first female chancellor for a state university. The region is special to Yanjmaa's heart, as she knew the difficulties of that remote area. Even though she left there in 2015, some of her former faculty thought enough of her to prepare a feast, involving a whole sheep – in a ger (yurt). The new GSM counseling center in Khovd will be in a ger. She also drove eight hours to the even more isolated city of Ulaangom to preach.

ADDENDUM CONTINUED

The trip ended on a highlight, with crowded venues during the last week that Yanjmaa was back in Ulaanbaatar. At Bethany Village Church, more than 200 people packed into a room meant for 130. At Yanjmaa's home congregation – Uurdin Gegee Church – 350 people gathered to hear her. She did counselor training for 70 people and had a healing and deliverance service for 20 pastors. Total costs for the trip were \$14,000, and when Yanjmaa boarded the plane at the beginning of the journey, that money had not yet come in. By the end of her three weeks there, it had, chiefly from the Mongolians themselves. A YouTube video of the trip highlights can be seen here.
