Her treatment lasted for 4 months and with concerted prayers God restored her health and life. Also three other homeless Ladies and widower and son. The widower's wife was a nurse, a good member of GSM, Port Harcourt. She died of diabetes and blood related complex case. She is yet to be buried because of lack of funds as her husband is presently jobless and homeless. Please join us to pray for the family. Their only child is now staying with us here with no obvious means of school fees. We also spent quality months (2 months) with our National Director of Cameroon - Papa Tangye George and his wife Patricia when he stayed here with us both in hospital (prostate enlargement surgery) and GSM centre here. The Lord perfected his health medically and spiritually before he went back home. Strange healings and deliverance on many clients and restoration of broken marriages. Reconciliations on intractable legal complex cases were settled by the Lord in strange ways in the ability of God etc
