CLASSES & WORKSHOPS

- Cindy Womack taught a class on Suicide intervention for 25 participants, as well as a special class in Alexandria on Regulating our nervous system and Polvegal theory, for 55 participants.
 - In October, we had a blessed visit from 2 teachers from Mesites Christian Academy, South Africa, along with our Jordanian friend Caroline, who introduced them to our office. They gave training on the following:
 - neuro-biology model in therapy
 - Childhood abuse and Trauma therapy
 - Play and creative Therapy
- Family counseling: A system approach & EFT Model for couples therapy.
 - 30 live participants attended plus live Stream participation, for the first time, via zoom, for those residing outside of Cairo or abroad.

GROUPS

- A monthly open support group for caregivers (mainly individuals who care for a chronically ill family member), led by Marianne.
 - The group helped about 50 persons throughout 8 meetings.
- An open bi-weekly book club and movie evening, led by Enas.
 - About 50 persons participated throughout 16 evenings.



- A 12-week workshop for teens' parents, led by Ebtesam and Rasha.
 3 couples
 - 7 single parents shared on the workshop.
- 3 one-day classes of art therapy, led by Mosheer.
 - 2 classes in Cairo and one in Alexandria.
 - The average of participants was 13 for each.
- Weekly group therapy for "Attachment disorder in adults"
 - for 17 participant's
 - will remain running up to April 2024.
- A new weekly group therapy for "Attachment disorder in adults" in Alexandria, under the new title "2 Connect".
 - It consists of 16 participants
 - remain running up to April 2024. Led by Mosheer & Marianne.
- 2 testimonies from group members:
 - "The group is making a huge difference in every aspect of me, mentally, socially & and emotionally. Through its turns, through the exercises we make, as well as the articles we discuss together, I find myself learning and changing a lot

• "I feel so grateful to the group members, especially Marianne and Sarah. Masheer, my highest achievement in 2023 was that I got to know you and got disciple by you. This will continue." (S. M) "Almost a miracle happened to me at the hands of the Attachment Group. Every now and then I would try to commit suicide and fail, and then walk away and leave the house then come back again. I was classified as having a borderline personality disorder, and every time I joined any course or group they would walk me away, and this made me hate people and hate myself even more. Until I joined this group, I asked Mosheer: "When will you walk me away?" He said, "I will not walk anyone". He tolerated a lot of toxic words from me and he never criticized me. He has a special personality and a leadership type in the group, and he never hurt me or told me to leave. I learned from him to accept my weakness, and to love myself. I also learned how to express and describe my feelings, and to practice mindfulness exercises to calm myself. I learned how to befriend my inner child instead of hating myself. learned how to stay with my pain instead of running away from it using relationship addiction. I learned that I am a human being and that no human being is perfect. I learned that imperfection is a gift, not a curse." (Ch. V.)

COUNSELOR TRAINING

- A continuation of the new counseling training class (level 1 & 2) that started in 2021 and ended last April, including weekly discussion groups for 170 students.
- A practical training (Pre-Internship) class for 25 graduates of the previous training, led by Mosheer.
- A continuation of the new counseling training class (level 1 & 2) in Alexandria, which will go until April 2024, including weekly discussion groups for 60 students. Led by Mosheer.
 - 2 testimonies from Alexandria's students:
 - "The weekly group discussion, whether live or Zoom, after watching the amazing teaching on YouTube, was just insightful and fun. The books we read were so well selected. The whole Study had a positive impact on me in a personal aspect, in that I acquired the ability to listen more than talk.  - "Years of hard work and experience, as well as rich materials have poured in this study for free, with love!!  - New 10 students joined the online counseling study (level 1 & 2) in 2023, plus 79 continue from the previous years. They are from different countries as well as different governorates of Egypt.
